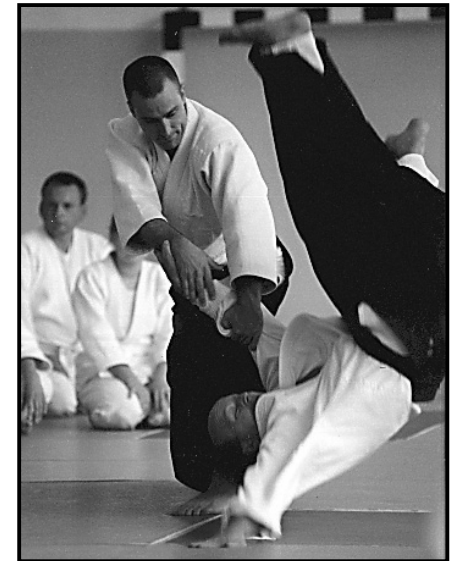

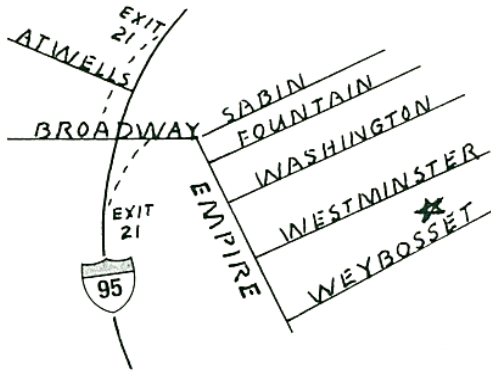

FROM 95 North: Take Exit 21 at Broadway. Turn Right at the light on to Broadway.

FROM 95 South: Take Exit 21 at Atwells. Go straight to the second light. Turn Left on to Broadway.

FROM Broadway: Curve Right on to Empire. Turn Left on to Weybosset Street. Pass the Providence Performing Arts Center. Aikido - Downtown is at 153 Weybosset Street on the 2nd floor in Charles Earle's Uechi Karate School across from the Johnson & Wales Gates.

All Aikido Shinjinkai East Coast Summer Training sessions are open to students of any level, rank, organization, or martial art as well as police, military, security professionals, and the general community.

Along with a strong emphasis on Aikido basics, instruction this year will stress correct transmission of the complete training material from the late Fumio Toyoda Shihan, including: a detailed break-down and explanation of aikitaiso, the complete taisabaki ho (toshu and with bokken), kumitachi and kumijo, and a number of individual techniques that were unique to Toyoda Shihan and not widely taught to the public. We will be practicing for five days and 30+ hours of exciting Aikido!

SHOCHUGEIKO is Aikido Shinjinkai's summer training seminar, this year hosted in beautiful and historic Providence, RI. Traditionally held at the height of summer, Shochugeiko is an opportunity to break through to new levels in your practice, and to re-dedicate yourself to your martial arts. August is also a wonderful time of year to enjoy the historical city of Providence - centuries-old architecture, the river walk, waterfront, fantastic restaurants, theaters, and excellent beaches in Southern RI. KEITH MOORE is Chief Instructor of the Aikido Center of Chicago - Shinjinkan Dojo, and Director of Aikido Shinjinkai. Moore Sensei lived for six years as *uchideshi* (live-in disciple) under the late Aikido and Zen master Fumio Toyoda Shihan, and was named Shihandai, assistant, to that teacher. Formerly serving as General Manager and Director of the Aikido Association of America and Aikido Association International, he founded Aikido Shinjinkai in 2002 as an association of Toyoda Shihan's former students, devoted to promoting training in Budo (martial ways) and Zen. In 2003, the dojo of Shinjinkai affiliated with the United States Aikido Federation - Western Region, under the guidance of T. K. Chiba Shihan.

JOHN MAZZA is one of the most senior students of the late Toyoda Shihan, with a background of nearly forty years of martial arts training. Beginning Judo in 1965 in Korea, he went on to study Shotokan karate and then began Aikido in 1974. In 1977 he met Toyoda Shihan, and immediately moved from Philadelphia to Chicago to train with him. Mazza Sensei went on to hold numerous instructional and organizational positions under that teacher. Today he serves as Director of Aikido Shinjinkai, and is the Chief Instructor of Zanshinkan Dojo at Northwestern University, founded in 1974.
